This week in Maths, Year 2 have been working on measurement. They have been measuring heights, lengths, widths and weights. They learnt the different units of measures. In the pictures you can see that the children used scales to compare the weights. They went around the classroom measuring the heights, weights and lengths of different objects.

In English, they have been continuing their work based on the book *The Little Hen and The Great War*. They wrote their own versions of the story and included lots of amazing vocabulary they had learnt from their words of the day.




Reception have been reading *Owl Babies* by Martin Waddell and been thinking about day and night. The children discussed how you can see at night like the owls in the story and looked at the different sources of light we use. They explored shadows and created their own shadow puppets on a screen inspired by a group called Attraction.



Year 1 have been learning how to make numbers greater than 10. They worked in pairs to figure out how to make a number between 10 and 20 using bead strings, counters and number cards.

In English, they have been discussing emotions and how music makes you feel. They listened to Jazz music and then wrote about how they were feeling and how to describe those feelings. What music makes you smile?
