

Christmas Card orders out for delivery

Year 1 have been writing their own version of the book Stanley's Stick. In maths, they have been looking at ordering numbers from the smallest to the biggest. To help them, the children used ten frames, bead strings and number cards. In R.E, they have been learning about the Jewish holiday called Sukkot. They designed their own celebratory Sukkah. A sukkah is a hut constructed to have meals in during the festival of Sukkot.




In computing this week, Year 2 practised logging onto the Chromebooks. They practised writing their names on Google Docs, the children needed to make sure they had remembered to use a capital letter. Once they had written their names, they changed the size and colour of the font.

In English, the children have been writing questions, using words such as 'who, what, where, when, why'. They have learnt how to use a question mark instead of a full stop. Then they learnt the difference between a 'good answer' and an 'ok answer'. A good answer is a full sentence. See if you can practise answering questions in sentences at home.




Reception have been reading 'Handa's Surprise'. The children had to try and remember which animal took which fruit from the fruit hat. The children had a fun fruit tasting session at snack time this week, where they got to try lots of different types of fruit.

They have also been learning about repeating patterns using colours. Maybe you can make a repeating colour pattern at home.
