In a normal day, our class daily structure would look similar that listed below. We will give you guidance of what to do within each session but this may help give you some structure to your day. I have included a guide to how long the sessions would approximately last.

Welcome, discuss the day's activities and Word of the Day!	Chickens of the same of the sa	We will let you know what our word of the day is. It will link to our learning and we encourage children to use the word throughout the day.
Phonics activity 20 minutes	Phonics	Look out for the daily phonics activity.
Walk a Mile 20 minutes		Go for a quick paced walk for 20 minutes. It helps to pump blood to the brain!
Maths 30 – 40 minutes		Look out for the daily maths activity.
Reading 15 minutes		Listen to your child read. Can they answer questions about their book? Did they enjoy the book? Why/why not?
Playtime and snack		
English 30 – 40 minutes		Look out for the daily English activity.
Wake and Shake movement activity		Put on some music and dance!
Lunchtime and playtime		Can you make lunch together?
Relaxation session		Listen to some calming music or focus on your breathing for 5 minutes. Check on your starfish.
Wider Curriculum activity 30 - 40 minutes		Look out for the daily activity. It could be science, art, RE, geography, history, PE, PSHE, Music or Computing.
Story Time 15 minutes		Pick a story and read to your child.
