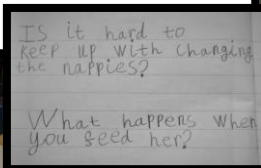

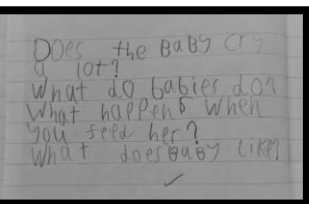

The children had to find out what colours can be made when mixing two prime colours together. Then made beautiful hand print pictures.

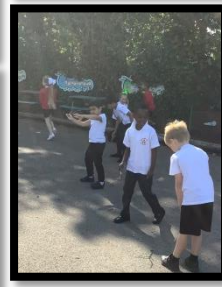


In Science, Year 2 have been learning about animal babies. They discussed how some animal babies look totally different to their adult, e.g. caterpillars and butterflies and how some animals look the same, such as panda's and humans. They played a game where they had to match up the babies to their parents. They talked about what they were like as a baby and thought of questions they could ask Miss Johnson about her new baby.



Year 1 have been reading 'Stanley's Stick'. The children found their own stick and pretended their stick was something else. The children came up with some fantastic ideas, such as a horse, a wand, a fishing rod and cooking utensils.

In Maths, we have been focusing on recognising and representing numbers in different ways. We used dice, beads, dominos, 10's number square and our fingers. What could you use at home to make up the same number in different ways?

Christmas Art Work

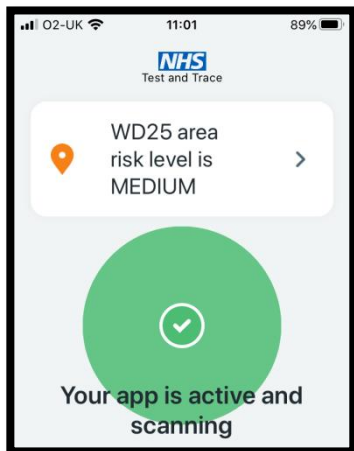
